Dear Friends:

Welcome to the 2023 Crawford County Junior Fair Sale. We have our usual fine offering of 4-H and FFA project animals raised by Crawford County boys and girls. We sincerely appreciate your past support and your presence here today.

All stock is selling at weights taken Saturday, July 15 and Sunday, July 16, 2023.

C&B Country Meats (419.562.5715), Gwartz Foods (419.342.6228), Glenville Packing (419-562-7171), Center Street Meats (419.617.1767) and Link's Country Meats (419.683.2195) will truck free of charge any animal that will be *slaughtered and processed* at their facility (processing fees are paid by the purchaser). The buyer is responsible for contacting the processor and making arrangements for processing.

Only poultry will be processed and delivered to the buyer at the exhibitor expense.

The Dairy Beef Feeders and Beef Feeders are not available for the buyer to keep/take home.

Arrangements can be made to resell most animal species purchased for promotional purposes. It is very important to make your wishes known before you leave the sale today.

Livestock will be removed on Sunday morning. The livestock committee members will be responsible for loading animals Sunday.

Terms of Sale: Cash, Check, Visa, Discover, or MasterCard Day of Sale. We will be charging a 3% Buyers Premium this year to all buyers. All buyers paying Cash or Check on sale day will receive a 3% cash discount. Make checks payable to "Junior Fair Sale."

How To Calculate Your Junior Fair Sale Expense

In an effort to keep the sale simple and more buyer friendly, we will be going to a Premium Bid at the auction. Bidding will not include the base price of the animal. Bids will be collected exactly as bid. The buyer is not responsible for the base price, unless they want to take possession of the animal or have the animal processed. If the buyer wants the animal, the total due will be the premium bid made at the sale PLUS the base price of the animal. Base prices will be listed in the sale program.

Buyers will indicate one of two options on their billing statement the day of the sale:

A. Buyer Keep

A. Buyer Keep - The buyer may elect to keep their steer, lamb, hog, goat, poultry, or rabbit. Buyers are responsible for the removal of these animals from the fairgrounds. Please indicate the name of the person picking up the animal at the time of check out. Animals cannot be released until Sunday at 7:00 a.m. Animals should be removed by 11:00 a.m. on Sunday!

B. Process (Indicate Where)

B. Process - The buyer may wish to have steer, lamb, goat, or hog slaughtered for their own use. **The buyer must indicate where they want their animal delivered for slaughter.** The buyer is responsible for contacting the slaughterhouse and making arrangements for processing.

Donuts and coffee will available to the Buyers in the morning and a Lunch will be provided around noon. The Donuts and Lunch will be served at the West end of the arena. Water will be provided throughout the day, buyers are welcome to help themselves at any time.
