**Photo of dog and current license & rabies vaccinations must be submitted wi application.**

1. Competing race dogs must be a certified wiener dog. Your dog does not have to be AKA or AKC registered/certified. Please bring your dog's shot records that clearly indicate "dachshund" breed- We have the right to disqualify any dog based on questionable breed. Mix breeds are not permitted. The judges have the right to disqualify any dachshund mix breed.
2. only the dachshund registered to race are allowed in the Crawford County Fair (NO SPECTATOR CANINES ABE ALLOWED) Total of 40 canines will be allowed to participate. ALL MUST BE PRE-REGISTERED BY JULY 14 AT 2PM.
3. A starting gate will be utilized, and dogs will race off leash.
4. Each dachshund will race 20 yards on the Crawford County Track
5. Each participating dachshund will be need to bring two(2) humans. Humans must be able to carry and catch the dog while standing/walking on a dirt/stone surface.
6. One human will carry the dog to the starting line and hold the dog. The other human will stand at the finish line and catch the racing dog.
7. All humans must clean up after their dog and dispose of any waste in trash cans. No waste can be left behind on the grounds or racetrack
8. All humans are required to sign a consent waiver releasing The Crawford County Fair from all liabilities and allow The Crawford County Fair to use their names and likeness in promotional advertising.(Must be completed before race time)
9. No dog food is allowed on the racetrack The Humans may coax their runner with favorite chew toy only andlor call the dogs. No dog whistles or the other shrill whistles are allowed. Nothing breakable or edible is allowed on the racing surface. No throwing of objects/toys is allowed. (NO balloons or doggie treats)
10. Thunans should not carry any loose articles on the racetrack. lltunans should wear comfortable shoe. No flip-flops allowed on the racetrack
11. Participant check-in on July 2e will be on the grandstand apron, must arrive prior to 3:30pm. At check-in each dog will be provided their qualifying heat information and timeline of events.
12. Participants will be responsible for bringing their canine to their designated race(an announcement will be mule). Participants are not allowed in the race area until their designated race.
13. Participating canines are not allowed trackside except for their individual race. Canines must be kept in the designated area.
14. Upon completion the wiener dog race, all participants MUST RETURN their dog's assigned racing jacket to personnel and exit the rake area
15. Remember these races are for fun only! The Judges' decisions are finaL For safety of everyone concerned to the humans and canines that don't meet all qualifications of the race. Any aggressive canines or canines exhibiting dangerous behavior will be asked to exit the track and The Crawford County Fairgrounds.
16. Theses races are held rain or shine.
17. Dogs must have current license and must be up to date on all shots including rabies vaccination. Owner must provide proof by the day of event
18. No Canines allowed on the midway, unless they are in a stroller and strapped in. The canine must leave the grounds after the races are completed.

Waiver, Release and Discharge from any and all liability for my death, disability, personal injury, property damage, property theft or acts of any kind which may hereafter accrue to me from this event, Crawford County Fair, its officers, members, event holders, event sponsors, event directors and event officials.

Indemnify and hold the entities or persons mentioned in the paragraph from any and all liabilities or claims made by other individuals or entities as result of any actions during this event I hereby consent to receive medical treatment, which may be deemed advisable in the event of injury, accident and/or illness during the event I understand that in this event or related activities that I may be photographed/filmed. I agree to all my photos, video or film likeness be used for any legitimate purpose by the event holder, producers, sponsors and organizers.
